MMC's first partnerships in Dual Credit were formed in 1996 and have proven to be very successful and an educational asset to students who take advantage of this time and money savings program.

Benefits

- High School Dual Credit Courses: \$60/CR
- SILDL Distance Education Courses: \$95/CR + book

Eligibility

- Students must obtain approval from a guidance counselor, teacher, or other appropriate personnel
- Students must be approved for advanced placement courses or meet two of the following criteria:
 - Cumulative GPA of 3.0
 - Min. grade of "B" in prior content-related courses of *Step Ahead*
 - Min. ACT score of 21 in content-related sub test
 - Rank in the top half of the class
